TRANSCRIPTS

High school seniors must submit the most recent official complete high school transcript **AND S.A.T scores. All transcripts must be official and sent in a sealed envelope.**

Applicants should provide the name of the College or University to which they have been accepted.

Alternately applicants should name the College or University they expect or wish to attend.

Applicants must submit a type written **ESSAY** of approximately 250-300 words, on the following topic:

“The principles of Hellenism is deeply rooted in the American dream fueled by hard work and our immigrant fore bearers.”

In your essay convey how a **PERSON** from another country achieved this dream and what did you learn from that experience

Applicants must include two letters of recommendation, i.e.the applicant's teachers,counselors, advisors, professors,etc

Neither reference should be related to the applicant. Letters of recommendations should be included with the transcript
